Construction is currently underway! A joint-use facility to replace Argyle School and Ecole St. Pius X elementary school is being built at the current site of Argyle School in the Lakeview neighborhood. By the 2023-2024 school year, we will welcome 800 students to a new joint use school.

With the construction of the school facility, we are looking ahead to play structures. Playgrounds provide opportunity for socialization, teamwork and practice with conflict-resolution skills.

Our proud community has a chance to build a playground worthy of our neighborhood's children. That is why Argyle School Community Council is spearheading a funding campaign.

### Building a playground is a complex game.

The process for building a playground is driven by the specific needs of our community. This grassroots effort includes:

- Assessing our community's needs.
- Establishing community-level partnerships.
- Applying for grants, hosting hot dog sales, raffles and auctions.
- Site design and development.
- Selection of playground equipment and materials.
- Safety consultation and review.
- Construction and ongoing maintenance.
