



Regina Public Schools' Return-to-School Safety Plan



Mandatory Masks

Masks must be worn by all staff, visitors and students from Grades 4 to 8. Mask usage is highly recommended for students in Pre-K to Grade 3. Non-medical, reusable masks should be washed daily. Students may bring their own masks but they cannot be a bandana or buff.



Daily Self-Assessment

Before school, check for symptoms. If not feeling well, stay home and call 811. Use the [SHA online self-assessment tool](#) and check government [procedures for illness and care](#).

Visitors Restricted in Schools

Student drop-offs and pick-ups must be done outside. Please check the school website for details.



Transportation

Buses will be disinfected after each trip. All students and drivers must wear face masks. There will be assigned seating.



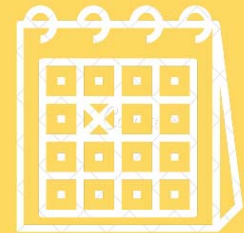
Adjusted School Day

Students will remain with their classmates and within their designated classroom during the day. Contact between classrooms of students will be restricted during transition times such as in and out of the school and during washroom breaks. Check the school website for start, lunch and end times.



Staggered School Start

Check the school website to see when your child/ren will start classes.

Physical Distancing

Schools will have specific entrances and exits, staggered transitions and designated lineups for physical distancing.



Hand Washing/Sanitizing

Frequent hand washing/sanitizing is mandated. Students may bring their own unscented hand sanitizer.



Water Bottles

Students should bring their own filled water bottles to school.

Disinfecting

All school spaces will frequently be disinfected, including spot cleaning and sanitizing of surfaces.



Stride over to School

Getting to school safely and in a physically distant way means to walk, bike, run and stride over to school! To help avoid car congestion, please do not drive or stop vehicles within one block of your school.

Playgrounds

There is restricted public access to school playgrounds. Please stay off school grounds from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.



Lunch

Students are encouraged to go home for lunch if possible. Students staying at school for lunch will remain with their cohort.
